

Internal Training Policy

Prior to starting the course, the employer will inform employees of course particulars such as date, time, location and cost. After which the employee will sign a Training Acceptance Agreement.

Proof of successful completion must be submitted within 15 days of course completion. If proof of successful completion is not received within 15 days, or if the employee leaves Apex Forest & Wildfire Services, monies will be reimbursed to the employer according to the following schedule:

- a. Same Season – 100%
- b. Second Season – 66%
- c. Third Season – 33%
- d. Fourth Season – 0%
